The C-Flex Command & Control system is a modern, flexible solution that supports the full mission cycle for maritime domain security and surveillance by integrating the shipboard sensor and weapon systems to generate a real-time confident situational awareness display. The accuracy and effectiveness of the C-Flex system allows for the Commanding Officer to make time-critical decisions and perform efficient engagement in missions like law enforcement, search-and-rescue (SAR) and peace keeping/ self-protection.

The C-Fire EO system is a combination of advanced Thermal Imager, TV camera, and eye-safe laser range finder providing the ability to engage targets to the maximum effective range of all in-service naval guns. The system is designed to be operated both as a fire control system in 'hostile' scenarios and as a surveillance and identification device.

The C-Raid Command & Control system is a scalable solution designed to provide complete Situational Awareness and Command & Control capabilities enabling multiple units to work together as one by sharing a highly detailed, real-time common tactical picture. Compared to traditional voice communications, this integrated system significantly improves mission Command & Control, networking even the smallest platforms under the direction of a larger vessel or shore-based operation center.

The C-Series solutions, including the SCANTER 4100 radar, and the SCANTER 6000 Solid State radars for naval surveillance and helicopter guidance, and the proven C-Guard Decoy Systems are in use in navies and coast guards in e.g. the U.S., the UK, The Netherlands, Australia, Thailand, Indonesia, Romania, Norway, and Denmark.
